Exhibition catalogue for the solo show: *The Sleeper Awakes* by Gordon Cheung held at the Other Gallery, Shanghai, 2010 Sep 10 - Oct 10.

Using paintings, sculptures and animations, the show was based upon the narrative of the short story *The Sleeper Awakes* (1910) by HG Wells. The works addressed conditions of contemporary globalization but in a multi-layered fashion. The works were situated within a contemporary backdrop of global disasters: financial fiascos including multinational corporate collapse, political hijacking of democracy by special interest groups, an exponentially accelerating technology.
